- 5. Deadlines will be set to ensure you are given time to complete all assignments. I will give you time in class to complete your assignments. If you are using your

time well and cannot complete the assignment on time then more time will be given to you. All work is expected to be completed by the deadline. Late work will be given half credit.

- 6. Work can be made up if an absence is excused. If you know you are going to be absent ahead of time check with and get the assignment before you leave. This will give you more time to complete the assignment. Any assignment given on a day you are absent can be made up within one day of absence. Two days absences give you two days to make up. It is your responsibility to get the make up work. Always communicate with me when you are absent so you know what you missed.
- 7. This will be run concurrent to 5 other reading classes 2nd hour. During 2nd hour each student will be assigned to a classroom where skills are being taught that fit each student's needs. This means that, while I will be your official teacher and you on my class roster, I may not be your classroom teacher day to day. While working with other teachers in other classrooms my expectation is that you will be following their expectations.
