- 5. Work can be made if an absence is excused. If you know you are going to be absent ahead of time check with and get the assignment before you leave. This will give you more time to complete the assignment. Any assignment given on a day you are absent can be made up within one day of absence. Two days absences give you two days to make up. It is your responsibility to get the make up work. Always communicate with me when you are absent so you know what you missed.
- 6. There will be no sunglasses or hats worn in class. Radio/CD/iPods will not be allowed in class. Cell phones or other devices will not be allowed in class. Please keep the electronics in a safe place out of my sight. Any use of these devices in class will result in not earning points for the period of use.
- 7. This class will run, most days, as an individual paced class. Students will pre-test a chapter, and then will be assigned sections from the chapter covering concepts they do not understand. Students will then work through those sections on their own or with help as needed. Online concept checks will need to be completed and passed before moving onto the next section. At the end of each chapter the students will take a test for the chapter.
- 8. Grades will be based on individual effort each week in working through the selfpaced curriculum, as well as, test scores.
- 9. All other rules and guidelines are covered by the student handbook or Make Your Day.
